OKI "Fantomi", Sarajevo

OKI "Fantomi" Sarajevo has been established in 1995 when it started its first competition season. During this period the club won a number of trophies, medals and bowls in various domestic and international championships and leagues. The club OKI "Fantomi" has successfully organized international tournament "Sarajevo Open" 16 times and won 12 times; SPID, B&H won 2004; Iranian national team won 2005 and Russian national team won 2013 and 2017. Fantomi won the title of European Champions four times; 10 times won Euro League; five times



National Champions and two times the club was the winner of National Cup Championship. OKI Fantomi was honoured laureate of "6th April award" by the capital government for the overall achievement in sport and social life. In 2011 OKI Fantomi was awarded on the world level for helping mine related casualties.



The club works a lot with young players and succeeded to completely rejuvenate the team. This is a real guarantee that this club will continue to achieve top results in sitting volleyball.

In addition, the club is involved in numerous activities aimed to help persons with a disability caused by mines and unexploded ordnance in their socio-economic rehabilitation and reintegration. OKI Fantomi participate in realisation of a number of activities within projects *designed* to help disabled persons, such

as the project of Mine Risk Education for children that the club is implementing together with the Mine Detection Dog Centre in Bosnia and Herzegovina - MDDC.











Although the war in Bosnia and Herzegovina is behind us, mine contamination is still a huge threat to the security of its inhabitants, and an obstacle to the development of communities affected by mines.

Even so many years after the war and enormous efforts to reduce the mine threat, Bosnia and Herzegovina remains heavily contaminated. General estimate of the mine/cluster munitions contamination is that 129 municipalities/towns are under the threat with 1.398 communities directly threatened with mines and 60 communities threatened by cluster munitions. 15 % of the BH population or 545.000 people live under the constant threat of mines and cluster munitions.

Project CHAMPS - Children Against Mines is implemented in Bosnia and Herzegovina by Mine Detection Dog Center in BH in cooperation with Sitting Volleyball Club Fantomi. CHAMPS is the project of Marshall Legacy Institute and through cooperation with six elementary schools in Bosnia and Herzegovina from different ethnic groups, children help mine survivors receive necessary help. 16 mine survivors have been helped so far, mostly with sophisticated prosthetic limbs. Together with mine risk education instructors, children also help promoting safe behaviour through interactive workshops, mine risk education presentations in schools and mine affected communities and through media. Bosnian children communicate between themselves and with schools children in USA and



together they learn how to really make a difference. Children here participate in sitting volleyball games with their hero athletes from Fantomi club and play exhibition games in their schools. For children is not only fun playing volleyball sitting down, but also very educational.











ITF Enhancing Human Security



ITF Enhancing Human Security is a humanitarian, non-profit organization established by the Government of the Republic of Slovenia in March 1998. Its initial purpose was to help Bosnia and Herzegovina in addressing the consequences of the conflict and severe mine contamination. In the 20 years of its work, ITF's activities expanded beyond South East Europe and mine action. Today, ITF addresses the whole spectrum of human security in post conflict societies, including mine action, physical security and stockpile management, human rights, capacity building and advocacy. Nonetheless, ITF remains committed to continue supporting mine action in Bosnia and Herzegovina until the last mine.

Until end of 2017, ITF implemented over 195 million USD of donor funds and, among others, cleared around 80 million square meters of former minefields in Bosnia and Herzegovina alone. More than 40,000 mines and unexploded ordnances (UXO) were found and destroyed on 2,500 different locations

in BIH. In close cooperation with all other mine action stakeholders in BIH, ITF has contributed to diminishing mine suspected area from 4.200 sq. kilometers in 1996 on 1.061 square kilometers in the beginning of 2018. Nonetheless, around 2 % of BIH territory remains contaminated with estimated 75,000 mines and UXO, which represent a direct threat to 500,000 people. BIH remains the most mine contaminated country in Europe.

From its inception, ITF managed to raise more than 433 million of USD of donor funds. Only in South East Europe, more than 137.6 million square meters of suspected land was cleared with the assistance of ITF.

ITF would like to express special gratitude to the Republic of Korea, which enabled the organization of this year's "Sarajevo Open" tournament with its generous donation.









Sarajevo Cable car



Following the official opening ceremony on April 6, Sarajevo City Day, Trebević Cable car is again operational.

The Trebević Cable car connecting Bistrik with Vidikovac on Trebević has started from the starting station again towards Trebević, as it was in 1959 when it was built. The Cable car connected Bistrik, located 583 metres above sea level with Vidikovac on Trebević, located on 1.160 metres above sea level, and it was designed and built by Czechs. With a length of 2.100 metres, the Trebević Cable car was the longest one at that time. It was renewed in 1984 when Sarajevo hosted the Winter Olympics.

The first Cable car was completely destroyed during aggression on B&H from 1992 to 1995. It took 26 years for the Cable car to connect again old city settlement Bistrik with Trebević.

Reconstruction of Sarajevo Cable car would not be possible without two wonderful persons - Edmond Offerman and his wife Maja, who donated about 4 million Euros.

The Cable car is equipped with 33 cabins, each with ten seats, with a capacity of 1,200 passengers per hour. Instead of 12 minutes needed to come to Trebević with old Cabin car, the new one will bring you there for seven minutes and 15 seconds.














The Venue

Sport Hall "Ramiz Salčin", Mojmilo

Competition will be held in the Sport Hall "Ramiz Salčin", in the Olympic urban part Mojmilo. It is very near the city centre and is linked with it by public traffic.

The venue will be the central court for playing matches. Floor is parquet. Beside the playing court there is also training court.



Sport Hall is of 1000 seats for audience. Each of four separated dressing rooms is of appropriate size and comfortable, meeting all teams' needs.

Accommodation

Hotel "Terme", Ilidža

All teams will have an accommodation in luxury Hotel "Terme" in Ilidža.

Hotel is located in the vicinity of the Sport Hall and about 15 minutes from the International Airport Sarajevo. It is surrounded by beautiful parks and is very close to popular picnic place Vrelo Bosne (Well of the River Bosnia). This hotel is modern equipped and with kind hotel staff it is an ideal place for relaxation and spending nice time.
